Here are a few of the impacts this program has on our community just over the past year:

- -4 million pounds of food have been rescued.
- -1 million servings of soup have been prepared through our farm to food program
- -1.1 million meals have been made prepared and distributed through our community kitchen
- -510,000 people have received food assistance.

We are proud to share with you that since the inception of the program in 2012 we have rescued over **20 million** pounds of fresh and prepared foods to put on the plates of those who are hungry. This last year has been difficult for many of us as we all have been faced with a unique set of challenges, however the most vulnerable have been impacted the most during these unprecedented times. The need in our community for access to healthy, affordable food has grown exponentially, and those experiencing hardship need your support now more than ever.
